Fire Chief Oak VonSeggern made a request to the City Council to assist in paying for asphalt in front of the Fire Station at 15 Hwy 31. Chief VonSeggern explained that the developer for The Centre at Rainey Creek (Shane Fleming) offered to include the Fire Station in the paving the development. The cost is estimated at \$15,500 with a bid from Depatco Construction. Mr. Fleming agreed to pay one half, Bonneville County agreed to pay \$3,750, Fire Department agreed to pay \$2,000 and would like the City of Swan Valley to pay \$2,000.

Mike Allen and Ken Hutson abstained from the discussion because they volunteer on the Swan Valley Fire Department.

The Council discussed the request. Dusty Jacobson made the motion to table the discussion until the February meeting. Stacy Crnkovich seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

The Council discussed the Council President appointment. The Mayor requested that Mike Allen continue as the Council President.

The Council discussed training for the Mayor and Council. City Clerk agreed to arrange a time and day with Legal Counsel.
