Mayor Hampton called the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

The council added Dust Abatement to the agenda as a discussion item.

The council discussed the previous process of dust abatement, which roads and the cost. Last year the county charged the city \$6540.21. The council discussed inviting a representative from Bonneville County Road and Bridge, to discuss road and bridge issues in the city.

Motion was made by Ken Hutson to approve the minutes for February 10, 2020. Stacy Crnkovich seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Motion was made by Mike Allen to approve the bills for February 2020. Dusty Jacobsen seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Doug Martin was at the meeting to discuss the tourism tax. He explained that when he served on the City of Driggs city council they adopted a tourism tax. The City of Driggs was able to make 1.2 million dollars in five years. The criteria for a tourism tax; resort town, under ten thousand population, two-thirds of a vote in an election, sunset clause, designated infrastructure and the percentage.

Doug Martin explained that County Commissioner Dave Radford had appointed him to represent Swan Valley and Irwin on the County Planning and Zoning Commission.

The meeting was adjourned.
